



Dear Friends,

I know it has been quite some time since we have been able to get out a prayer letter, but God has been ON THE MOVE!! Much has happened since and we are excited to fill you in!

For those of you who also follow us on Facebook, you might just get to Praise the Lord twice if I repeat some things in this prayer letter. :-)

This spring I traveled to Oklahoma and Texas for a series of local church meetings and prison ministry engagements.

I met with our local prison ministry volunteers and leaders at the Baptist General Convention of Oklahoma (BGCO) and discussed how we should move forward in our collaboration and plan to implement our Fresh Start (FS) curriculum in every prison in Oklahoma - great meeting! Jill and I are scheduled to return in September.

While in Texas, I joined with our local field representative and prison ministry volunteers and visited two new prisons to discuss FS implementation at each facility. The Chaplain's are excited to get started, however, we are now waiting for the official paper work to allow the startup of the program. I also preached and participated in a FS graduation at another prison where twenty-five responded for salvation in Christ and we graduated 30 students in 3 levels of Fresh Start. PTL!

Shortly after, I traveled to NC and assisted Pastor Peter McDonald and Midway Baptist Church in REVIVAL! (I share some highlights later in this news-letter. This was perfect timing for me because I was scheduled to preach on revival in Sarasota upon my return to Florida. Consequently, I personally experienced revival and hopefully brought with me the Spirit of revival to the Sarasota Church.

As I write this letter we are in our third week of revival here in Sarasota. I have preached a series of messages on revival and now I look forward to our closing sessions and hearing the testimonies of those who God has revived!

In Florida we were joined by our ministry team and ministered in 9 Florida prisons; graduated 20 FS students, preached the gospel and received over 100 first time professions of faith in Christ!

Once again we give God all honor, glory and praise for the many people who have received eternal life at our worship services in jails, prisons and churches across the country. Truly, the hand of God is upon us!

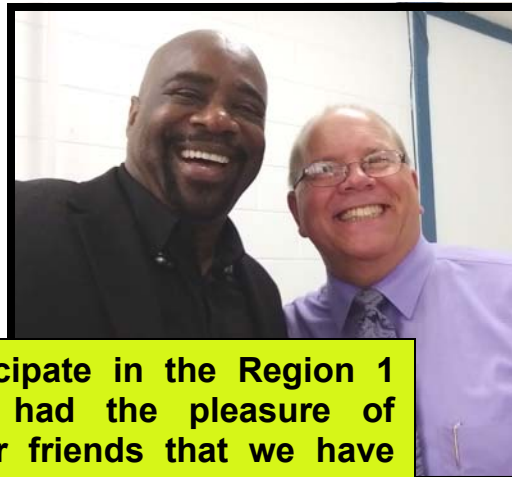
